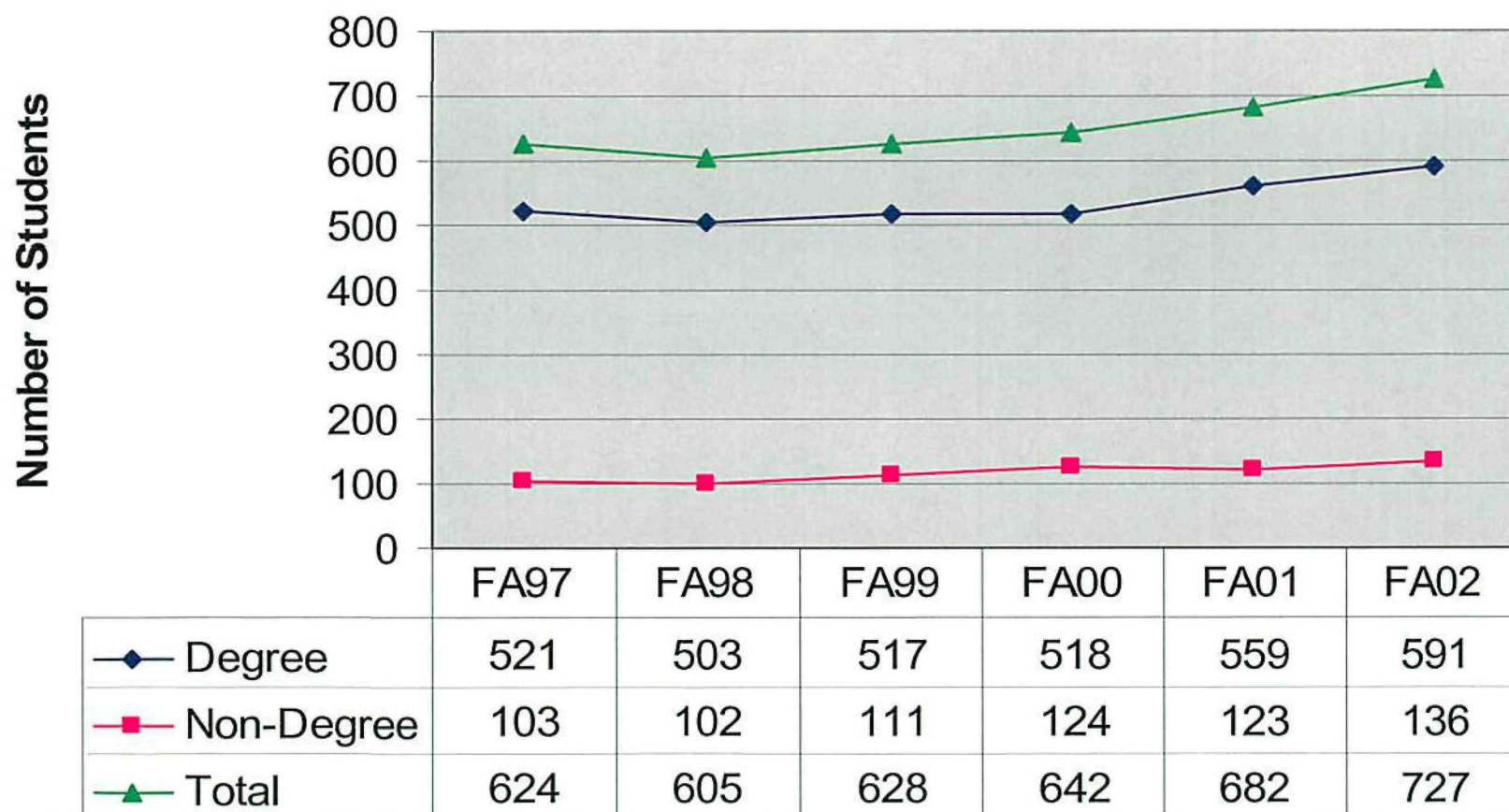

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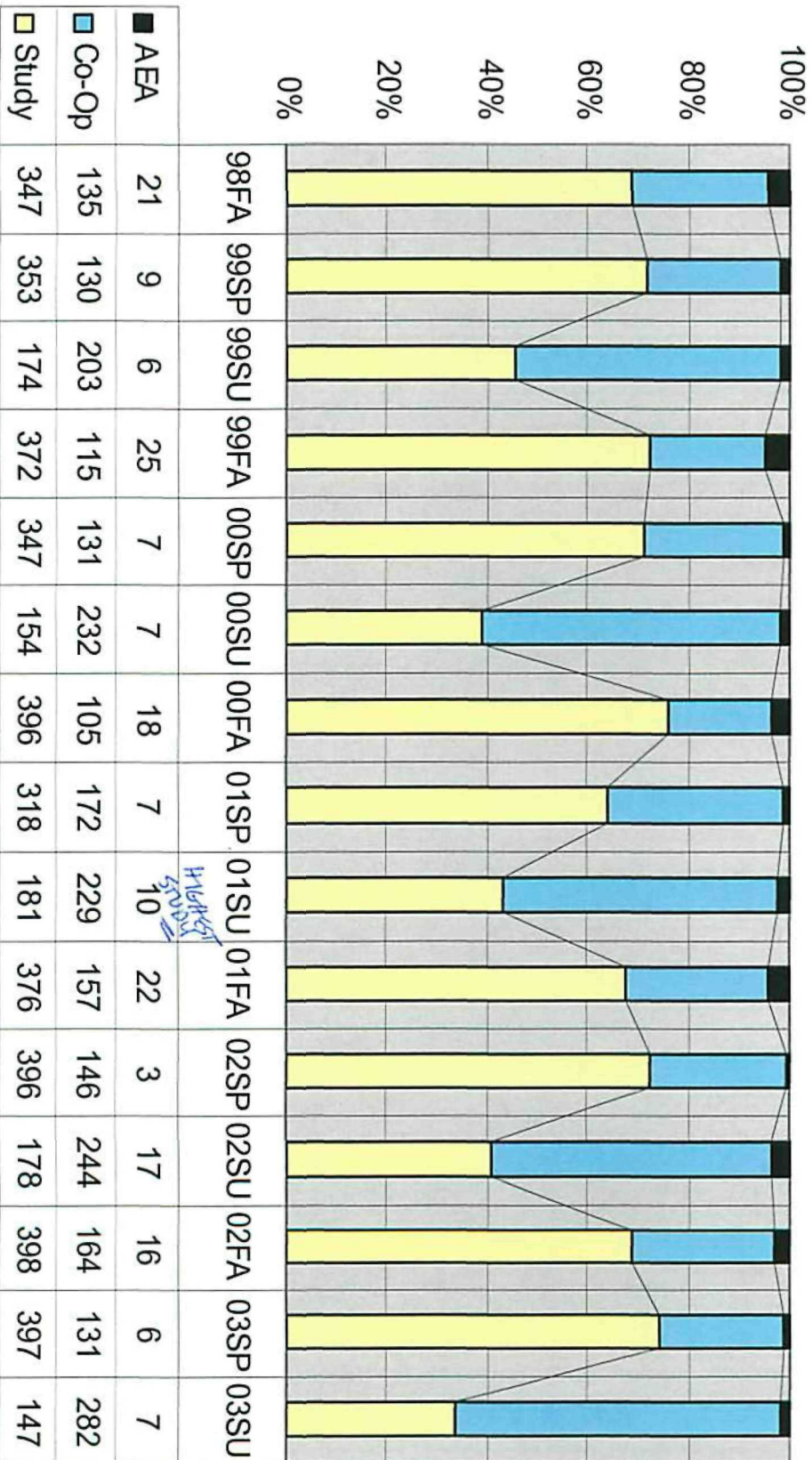

Fall Term Student Headcount (as of federal census date)

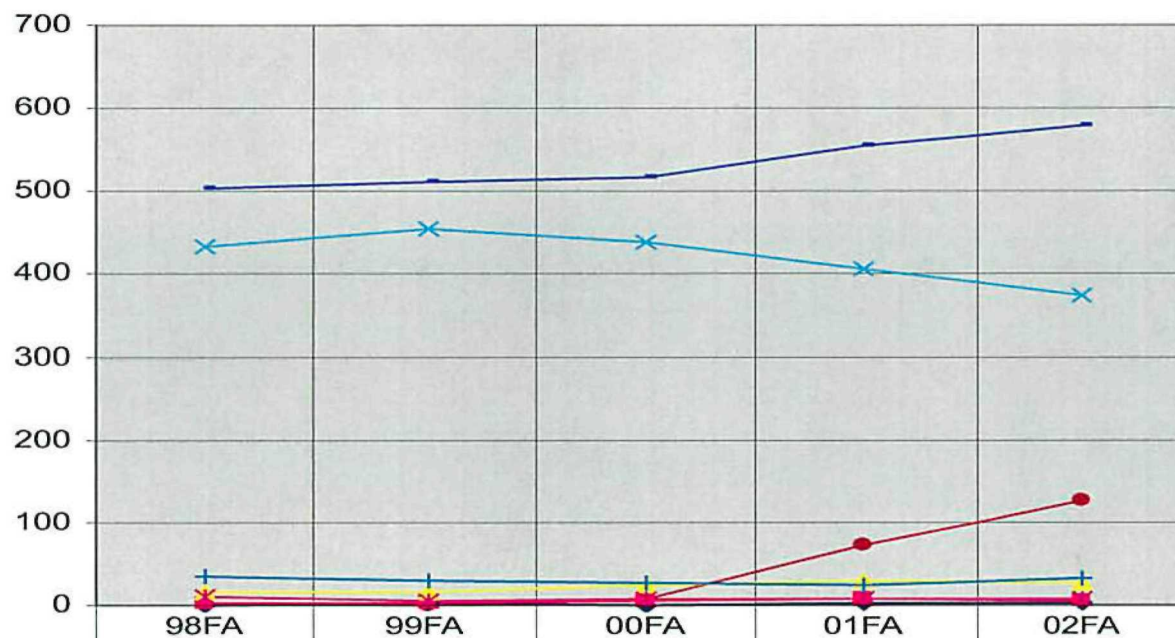


ANTIOCH COLLEGE **Sequenced Enrollment by Term** **(Full Term Enrollment)**

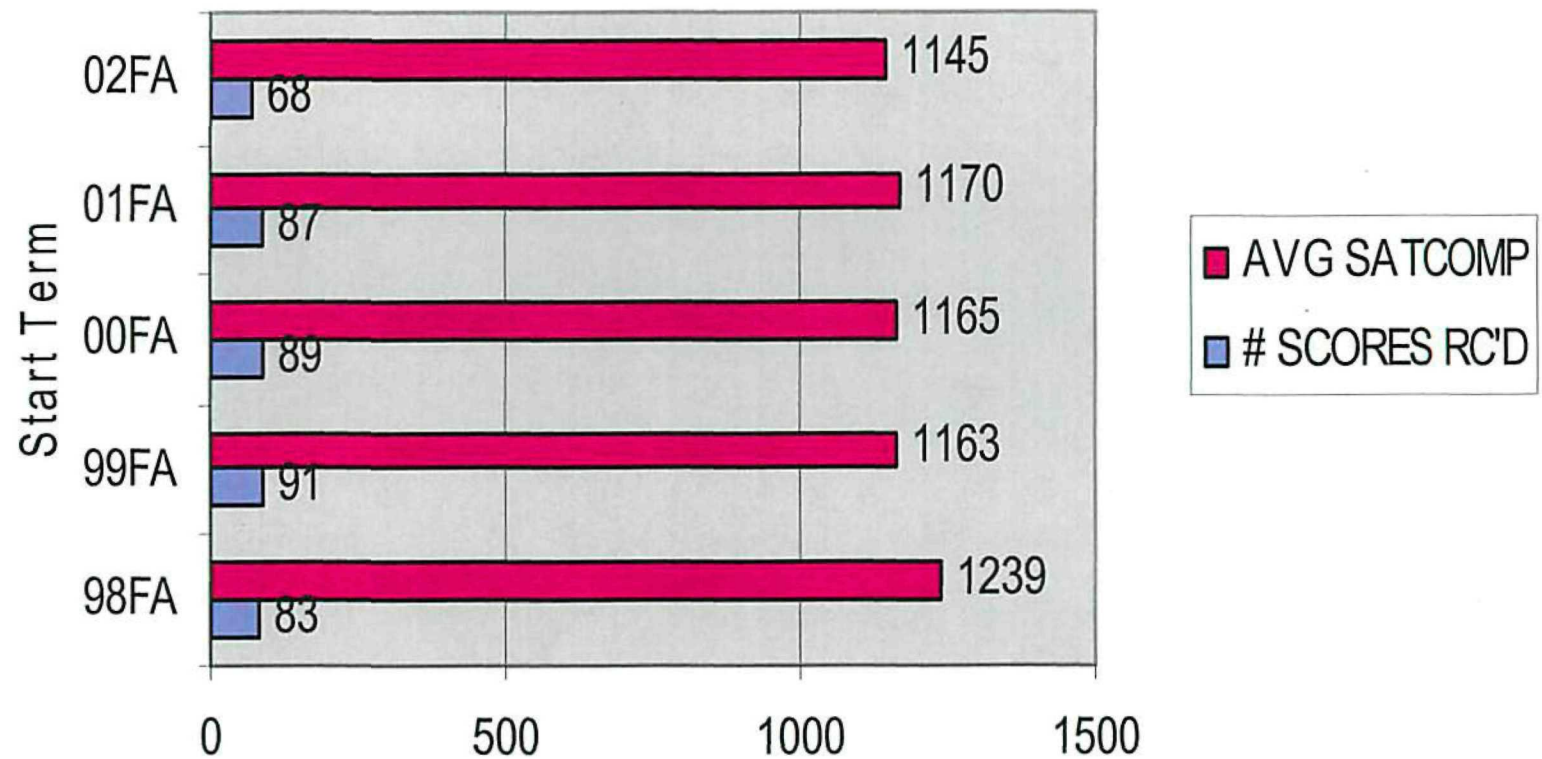

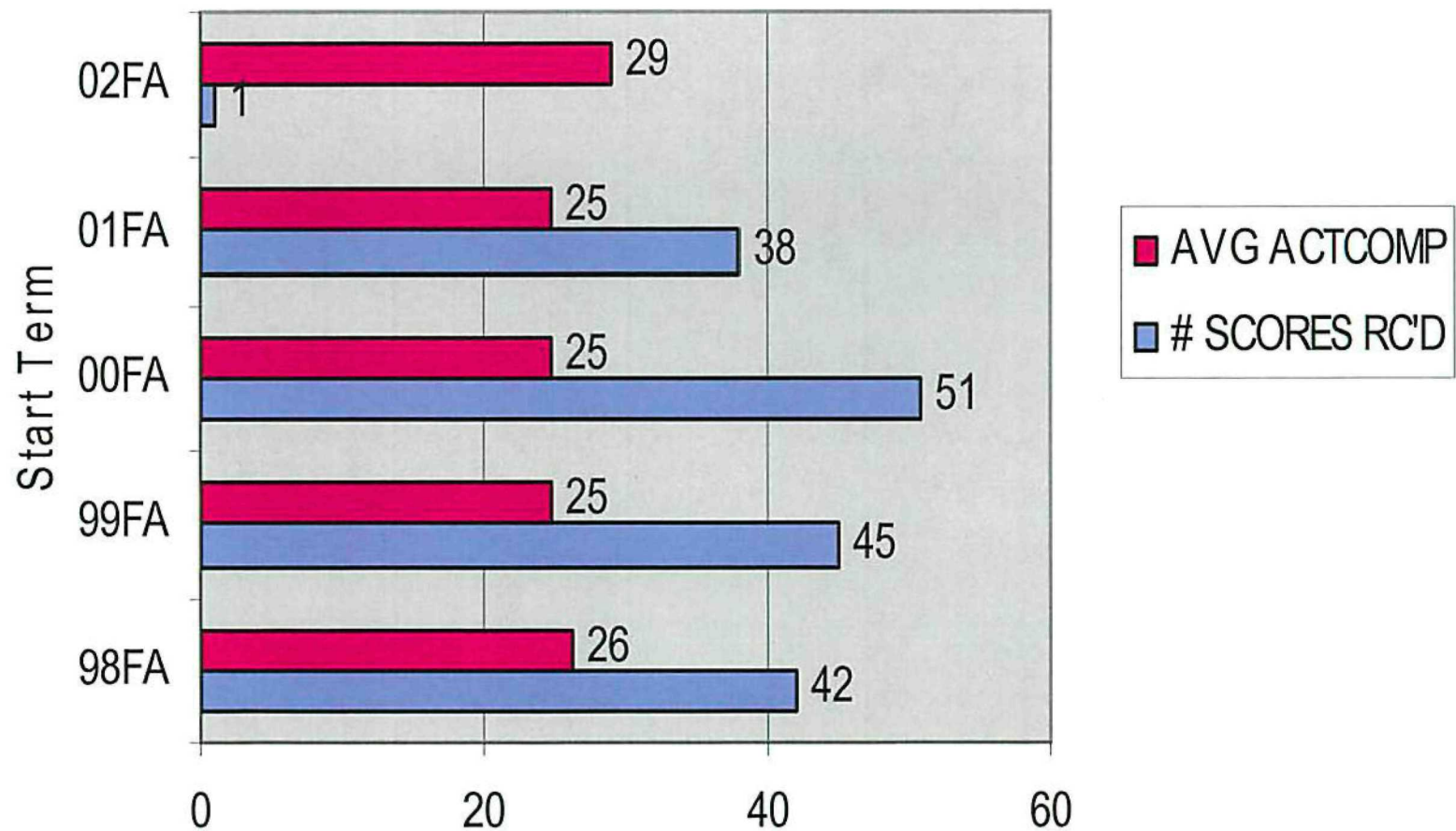

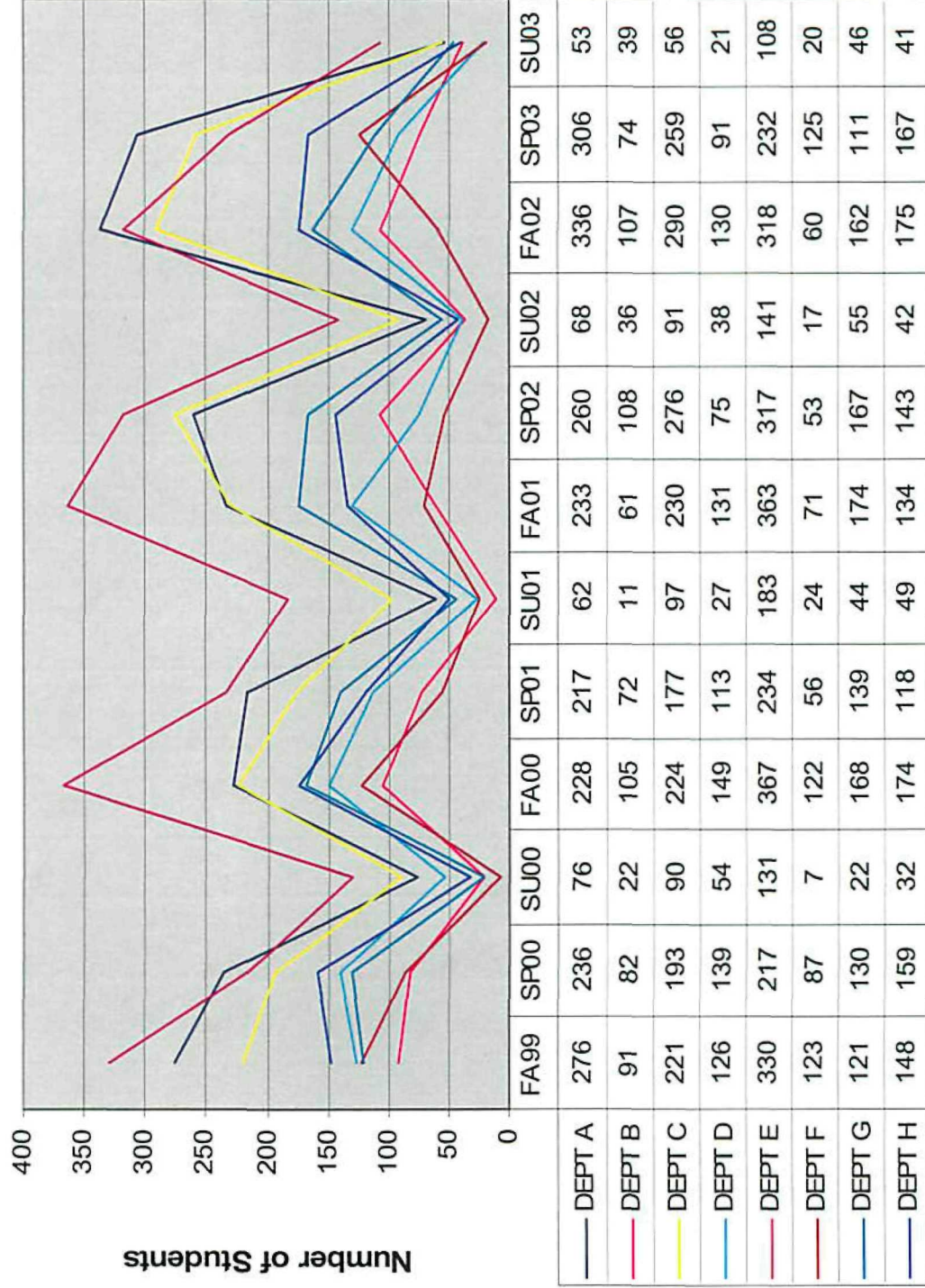
