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Smoking Policy

Antioch College complies with Ohio state law in not permitting smoking within campus buildings or within areas where smoke can enter buildings through doors or ventilation systems. Smoking is permitted only in designated smoking areas. Complaints about students' noncompliance should be taken to the Office of Community Life. Complaints about staff or faculty noncompliance should be taken to the chief operations officer. Violations occurring in residence halls are considered to be serious safety and health hazards and will also be referred to a resident life manager.

Note: Designated smoking areas will be determined in conjunction with the College administration, facilities, and the Office of Community Life. The specified areas will be at least 30 feet away from doorways and vents.
