

Change of a Major

Changing a major requires a student to seek advising support from the faculty advisor before a change of major can take place. Forms for declaring and changing a major are available in the registrar's office. Students may not change their major within two academic terms of their anticipated graduation.

A change of major may require a re-evaluation of transfer credit. Credits earned for courses in the previous major might not apply to the new major; these credits may be used as elective credits. In some cases, this may result in an abundance of elective credit that cannot be accommodated by the new degree plan. These courses will be considered "unused" courses; they will remain on the student's record but not count toward the degree.
