APPLICATION PROCESS

All Students

Financial aid is offered for one academic year at a time. Students must reapply each year. To apply for financial aid at Antioch, ALL students must submit ALL of the following:

- The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the Renewal Application. Be sure you answer all questions and that your application is signed and dated. Send to Federal Processor (Federal Student Aid Programs, P.O. Box 60006, East Saint Louis, IL 62206-6006). Be sure to list Antioch on your FAFSA or Renewal Application with our code, **003010**, and the Financial Aid Office will receive the results electronically.
- The Antioch Financial Aid Application, this form. Be sure you answer all questions and that your application is signed and dated. Send to the Financial Aid Office at Antioch.
- 1997 Parents and Student Tax Returns, all schedules. If a corporate tax return was filed, including subchapter S corporations, include 1120S and balance sheets. Send to the Financial Aid Office at Antioch.
- 1997 Parents and Student W-2s. Send to the Financial Aid Office at Antioch.

Some Students May Be Asked for Additional Information

Possible additional documentation may be requested, including:

- The Divorced/Separated Parent's Statement
- Student's who are independent according to Federal guidelines may need to submit parental tax returns and W-2s to determine eligibility for institutional aid.
- Verification of Sibling/Parent Enrollment

APPLICATION DEADLINES

- March 2, 1998 is the priority deadline for continuing students. (New students should apply for financial aid as early as possible but are afforded more flexibility in deadlines in their first year.) This means that the Financial Aid Office must receive the results of the FAFSA and tax returns and W-2s by this date. Students who apply after this date will have less aid eligibility; the later the application the less aid eligibility.
- Students from Alaska, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Vermont and the District of Columbia must apply for State Grants according to that states' deadlines. Failure to do so may result in loss of aid; students would be responsible to pay the amount the State Grant would have been.

AFTER YOU RECEIVE A FINANCIAL AID AWARD

- If you are awarded a Federal Direct or Federal Stafford Loan, a separate application will be sent.
- If you are awarded Federal Work-Study, you will need to bring to campus your US Passport, if you have one, or two forms of identification – a picture ID such as a Driver's License or State ID AND a Social Security card or Birth Certificate.

GENERAL POLICIES

The financial aid program seeks to make Antioch College programs financially accessible to students, to increase freedom of choice, and to provide opportunities to students who could not otherwise afford the expense of attending the college. Families have the primary responsibility for meeting college costs from parent and student income, assets and accumulated savings. However, financial assistance programs are available to families including payment plans, loans, grants, scholarships, and Federal and State aid.

The awarding of financial aid is linked to demonstrated financial need as the primary criterion for eligibility. The student is responsible for applying for Federal Pell Grant, State grants and scholarships, and local and national scholarships. Resources from Social Security, Scholarships, Trust Funds, and Veterans Benefits are considered part of the financial aid package.

Self-help – loans and work-study – is a component of the financial aid package. Each student who receives a financial aid award may be asked to borrow a specified amount from the Federal Direct or Federal Stafford Loan Program. In addition, some may be asked to borrow from the Federal Perkins Loan Program. Each student who receives a financial aid may be awarded Federal Work-Study to earn money to help with the cost of education. Gift aid is offered if a student has remaining unmet need. This aid comes in the form of Federal Supplemental Opportunity Grants and Antioch Tuition Grants (tuition discount).
