Scholarships for Continuing Students

2004-2005 Academic Year

Important General Information

Antioch scholarships include a variety of competitive awards. Because there are usually many applicants for each scholarship, general criteria have been established that pertain to all applicants, which are listed below. While financial need is considered as part of each applicant's overall set of qualifications, it is a determining factor only in those scholarships that specify financial need as a prerequisite for the award. Many Antioch Scholarships are limited by specific criteria and/or designated for specific purposes. Such restrictions are listed with each scholarship.

The following general rules apply to all applicants:

- Applicants must be in good standing academically (not on Warning or Probation), in regard to Co-op, and with the Dean of Students Office.
- Students must have a minimum of two paid tuition terms during the 2004-05 academic year to be eligible to receive Antioch scholarships.
- Some portion of an Antioch award may be counted in calculating the yearly amount of a student's Antioch Grant. The Financial Aid Office will provide scholarship recipients with details about these policies.
- The Scholarship Committee begins by awarding the largest scholarships first and continues in descending order until the smallest awards are granted. Once an applicant has been designated to receive an award, s/he is no longer considered for subsequent awards.
- Only **ONE** application is required to be considered for all scholarships listed in Section One.
- For scholarships listed in Section One, completed scholarship applications are due in the Financial Aid Office no later than 4:00 PM on Friday, February 6, 2004. **Applications submitted after the deadline will be considered only in the event any awarded scholarships are unclaimed.**
- For scholarships listed in Section Two, note the application deadlines and consult the contact person for application materials and any additional information.
