THE HARD-HITTING *FRONTLINE* DOCUMENTARY EXPLORES THE POLICIES, PRACTICES, IMPACTS, AND CONTROVERSIES REGARDING U.S. DETENTION FACILITIES IN GUANTANAMO, IN ABU GHRAIB, AND IN SECRET RENDITION SITES, BEING USED IN THE CURRENT "WAR ON TERROR." MANY SOLDIERS, INTELLIGENCE OFFICERS, LAWYERS, AND ANALYSTS ARE INTERVIEWED. (POSSIBLY ANOTHER SHOWING ON SEPT 30)

WHEN THIS PROGRAM WAS AIRED IN LATE 2005 FEW PEOPLE SAW IT AND THE PRESS IGNORED IT. WE THINK IT IS IMPORTANT TO BRING IT BACK IN THE CONTEXT OF RECENT DISCLOSURES IN ORDER TO PROMOTE FURTHER DISCUSSION ON U.S. FOREIGN AND DOMESTIC POLICY.
