Required Documents All students applying for need-based financial aid must submit:

☐ **FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) for 2004 - 2005**

Online FAFSA: It is best to complete the FAFSA online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. This method reduces both processing time and errors. If you file the FAFSA online, you may still need to print out, sign and mail a signature page to the federal processor. You can eliminate this step if both the student and a parent have PIN numbers. PIN numbers are assigned by the Department of Education and serve as electronic signatures. You and a parent can apply for PIN numbers at www.pin.ed.gov.

Paper FAFSA: Completing a paper FAFSA and mailing it to the federal processor is also an option. This method takes several weeks, so you will need to mail it, allowing enough time to meet the priority deadline of March 1st.

NOTE:

With either method be sure to list Antioch with our federal school code **003010**. **We will** receive your results electronically.

- To meet Antioch's priority deadline, it is best to complete your tax return early. If you cannot finish your taxes early, then complete the FAFSA based on estimated information. Once we receive your tax returns and all other application materials, we will make electronic corrections to the FAFSA data.

☐ **The Antioch Financial Aid Application for 2004-2005**

Answer all questions. If an answer is Not Applicable or "0" indicate that. Remember to sign and date your application. Send to the Financial Aid Office at Antioch.

☐ **2003 Federal Tax Returns for Parents and Student**

Send signed copies of these forms to the Financial Aid Office at Antioch. Include ALL schedules of tax return. If a Telefile form was filed, it must be signed, dated and include the 6-digit confirmation number.

☐ **2003 W-2 Wage Statements for Parents and Student**

Send copies of all W-2 forms to the Financial Aid Office at Antioch.

☐ **New Students Only**

Send a copy of your Social Security Card and Driver's License or other picture ID to the Financial Aid Office at Antioch.

Additional information will be requested by the Financial Aid Office as needed.

Deadlines

☐ **Continuing Students**

You must re-apply each year for need-based financial aid for the academic year that begins with Summer term. March 1, 2004 is the priority deadline. To meet this deadline FAFSA results and the Antioch Financial Aid Application must be received by March 1st, and copies of tax returns and W-2s must be post-marked no later than April 15th. Students who fail to meet the deadline will receive less Antioch Grant than if they had applied on time. The later the materials are received, the greater the reduction in Antioch Grant.

NOTE: If you are co-oping in the Summer and are considering a possible FWS supported position, ALL required documents are due by March 1, 2004.

☐ **New Students**

February 16, 2004 is the priority deadline. Students should apply for financial aid as early as possible, as some types of assistance are limited and may no longer be available to late applicants. However, new students are afforded more flexibility in deadlines in their first year.

- ☐ **Ohio, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Vermont** and the **District of Columbia** students must apply for state grants by the states' deadlines. Students who miss the deadline may be eligible for less aid.
