ANTIOCH FARM VOLUNTEER EXPERIENCE ON CAMPUS

3-week program: 9/11-9/29

Participants volunteer 35 hours per week between the Antioch Farm, Antioch Kitchens and other departments on campus. In exchange, students get familiar with campus and staff and make some new friends before their coursework begins. Participants are provided room and limited board (see below). Students should view this program as a work experience that may lead to further campus employment or job references in the future.

ANTIOCH CAMPUS ROOM & BOARD

Admitted students will share a room on campus with another admitted student or current student. Participants will eat with other students in the dining hall during the first week. A cold self-serve breakfast and prepared hot lunch and dinner will be available. Antioch Kitchens uses a large quantity of fresh, local produce and local, pastured meats. Produce and eggs from the Antioch Farm are also regularly prepared in the dining hall.

During the last week, the dining hall will close for break. Students will be on their own to prepare meals or eat in local restaurants. Some food from the Farm will be available for student use. Students in this program often choose to prepare meals together. Both the Farm and Yellow Springs are within walking distance of student accommodations.

WHO SHOULD APPLY

We are looking for admitted students, 18 years or older by the program start date, who have an interest in farming and food. Applicants should have a strong work ethic, the ability to work well with others and independently, and possess good time management skills. Applicants should also have the physical ability to do farm work and be outside in all weather conditions. Gardening or farming experience is a plus, but not required.

Send **cover letter**, **resume** and **completed application** by July 18 for priority consideration. Applications will be accepted until positions filled. Send to Kat Christen at kchristen@antiochcollege.edu.
