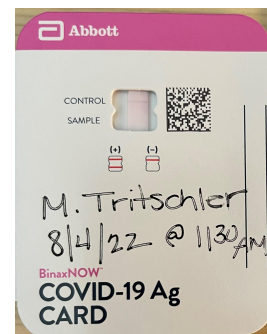
Thursday, August 11th
